8 Things to See, Do, and Eat in Palm Springs

With the tagline "Like no place else," Palm Springs is a hub for nature, design, and food aficionados. Depending on the decade, the city has served as either a quiet locale or a hip (and quick) getaway, and these days, entrepreneurs are dotting the landscape with innovative dining establishments and swanky hotels. Temps start to climb in the early summer months, attracting millennials who live to lounge poolside. Cool nights allow for exploration of the city's nightlife, including local karaoke venues where you can belt out your favorite Journey song. Desert scenery, fun culinary and entertainment options, laid-back vibe—all are in place at this inland oasis.

1. Ernest Coffee

Independent coffee shop Ernest Coffee serves Stumptown Coffee Roasters cold brew, "flat white" lattes, flaky pastries such as toasted- $^{1}\,\mathrm{of}\,^{3}_{a}$ lmond croissants, and gooey peanut-butter–chocolate-chip cookies.

2. Indian Canyons
